Pray: Apostle's Creed

Read: Rejoice! God is with us! Let us turn to Him—our infinite source of love. God so loved the world that He sent His Son, not to condemn the world but to save it. Our Lord built the path for us to travel which will lead us to Heaven.

Make no mistake, Jesus faced every human challenge that we face when He walked this earth. First Glorious Mystery The Resurrection

“Why do you seek the living among the dead?” [Luke 24:5]

Read: The Resurrection of Christ fulfills the promises made by God; it confirms all of Christ's works and teachings, according to the Catechism of the Catholic Church. Jesus admonished His disciples for not believing the word of His Resurrection from those who first saw Him after He had been raised. “Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed.” [John 20:29]

Christ opens for us the pathway to a new life. Therefore, why do we oftentimes seek fulfillment in life through ways that compromise our dignity and lead to sin? Why do we seek fulfillment in ways that take us away from God instead of closer to Him?

The choice is ours to make: To choose the path in life that is according to God's plan or the path that will lead us astray. If we choose the Lord's path to a new life, we will never be alone in living that life. Christ promised—confirmed by the Resurrection—to be with us always, giving us His body, blood, soul and divinity, bringing us and our world closer to Heaven.

Second Glorious Mystery

The Ascension

“At the right hand of God.” [Acts 2:33]

Read: Christ was raised up on the cross for our sins. Following His Resurrection, He was raised to Heaven for our salvation. “And when I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw everyone to myself.” [John 12: 32]

And as Christ was lifted toward heaven, His disciples were left with the promise that the Savior would come again. Christ raises our sights toward Heaven and at the same time, Christ dwells on earth in His Church. Each with the express purpose of raising us up in holiness.

Pray: Heavenly Father, protect me from spiritual stagnation and give me the strength to pray and do good works each and every day. Amen.

Third Glorious Mystery

The Descent of the Holy Spirit

“Receive the Holy Spirit.” [John 20: 22]

Read: On the day of Pentecost, the Holy Trinity is fully revealed [CCC 732]—God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. As the Father sent the Son into the world for our salvation, the Son pours out the Holy Spirit which comes from the Father. This glorious gift of love is ours for the keeping and for the sharing—that is our mission.

Mary and the first disciples show us what comes with the Holy Spirit. We are given divine inspirations from the Spirit’s gifts of wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord. In doing so, we savor the fruits of eternal glory by the Spirit: Charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control, and chastity [CCC 1831-32]

As we share in these gifts and fruits, we experience our own transformation into children of Light—the children of God. We see our purpose—to love as God has loved us. We understand what it means to be Christ-like and to see Christ in others. We recognize God’s grace in our lives, giving us the strength to follow Christ’s way with Mary our Blessed Mother by our side.

Pray: Spirit of the Lord, may your gifts and fruits guide me in every aspect of my life. Amen.

Fourth Glorious Mystery The Assumption of Mary into Heaven Heavenly Glory!

Read: Upon the completion of her earthly life, Mary, the Mother of God, was taken up body and soul into Heaven. Mary's Assumption into Heaven signifies the desire God has for all of us—to join Him body and soul in Heaven for all eternity.

Mary is the Church's model of faith and charity for every person in search of salvation. "In a wholly singular way she cooperated by her obedience, faith, hope, and burning charity in the Savior's work of restoring supernatural life to souls. For this reason, she is a mother to us in the order of grace." [CCC 968]

Pray: Heavenly Mother, by the power of your intercession, help me to embrace my God-given responsibility to share my faith, my hope and my love with those around me. Amen.

Reflection

- **How do you model yourself after Mary in your daily life?**
- **What obstacles do you face in living a holy life?**
- **Sit quietly and imagine yourself next to Mary holding her hand.**

Fifth Glorious Mystery The Coronation of the Blessed Mother

"May the Almighty Lord bless you forever." [Judith 15: 10]

Read: "A great sign appeared in the sky, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars." [Revelation 12: 1] Our Lady of the Rosary, Queen of Heaven and Earth, and mother to us all, Mary shares in her Son's work of our redemption. Intercessor, comforter, helper as well as our life, our sweetness and our hope, Mary takes on these roles to help us reach our salvation.

Our Lady calls on us to pray, especially the Rosary, to amend our lives and to ask pardon for our sins. Despite our sins, Mary draws us close for a deeper understanding and greater glory of the Holy Trinity. With that we gain the knowledge and the dignity of the Lord's love in order to share in the beauty that living in unity with the Holy Trinity can offer. Bringing forth such beauty, we can be flowering examples of God's love and mercy, and share in the Lord's work of redemption to keep the hope and promise of salvation—and eternal joy—alive.

Pray: Dearest Mother, you gave us your Son for our salvation. May our faith in Him never diminish. Thank you, dear Lady for all that you have done. Amen
